PASTOR JEFF'S JOTTINGS...

Pentecost is such a strange, mysterious and powerful Sunday, that, for some reason, we preach and teach so little about. I'm not sure why, because the presence of the Holy Spirit, which we acknowledge in worship and in our lives each and every day is all-consuming. Surely one would wonder why we don't spend more time calling attention to this day that infused the apostles and future leaders of the early church with an understanding of how Christ would forever live in their hearts and minds, and through their service.

The Holy Spirit, which I celebrate as winds of change, are moving, freely flowing – indicating that "things" are happening, that the spirit is among us and at work, hoping to make us a better people, a better church, in a better world. As ministries change, as leadership changes, as churches grow and decline, the Spirit is at work, calling us to be faithful, honest and true.

This Sunday, on Pentecost Sunday, we will baptize 5 individuals – adults and youth alike, who will make their Confession of Faith in the holy waters, and be immersed to eternal life by both Pastor Seth and myself. Later in June, while I am on vacation, there will be two more baptisms planned – all joyful celebrations of how God works in and through all of us. The Holy Spirit will be felt, experienced, and spread by all who come to witness, share, and be consumed by the energy that God releases in this symbolic act of the church.

Be in prayer that the Holy Spirit embraces each of those who will be baptized Sunday morning, and pray that the Holy Spirit continues to guide and direct our church, as the changing winds propel us forward. Neither churches or ministries are ever stagnant, when placed before the Holy Spirit, to be channeled for good.
